

# FAQ's

## *(Frequently Asked Questions)*

**Q.** *What do you do? / What are you about?*

**A.** Our mission is to help decrease the needless euthanization of Downriver animals; to help homeless animals from the cities of Trenton and Woodhaven find loving homes; and to educate the general public on the importance of spaying and neutering to control the pet population. We are not a shelter but we assist local shelters. We are a volunteer-run organization.

**Q.** *How much will it cost to spay or neuter my pet?*

**A.** We don't offer vet care services. Please call a vet to find out prices.

**Q.** *Can you pay for vet care for my pet (e.g. spaying, neutering, vaccinations, euthanization)?*

**A.** We don't offer vet care services. Please call a vet to find out prices.

**Q.** *I found a dog/cat. Can I come by and drop it off?*

**A.** We are not a shelter and foster homes might be full or unavailable. We will have to see if we have any room left in our foster homes. Otherwise, you will have to take the animal to your local shelter. Please see link to local shelters.

*Q. What are your hours of operation?*

**A.** We are a volunteer-run organization. We don't have a set time of availability. Volunteers return calls when their schedule allows.
